GENERAL INFORMATION

This is the Goodtime Quilters 30th Quilt Show. Our reputation continues to grow. In order to continue the quality and reputation of our show, we need and want every member to participate.

1. You will have an opportunity to indicate on the registration form whether or not you wish your entry to be judged. Please complete this form in BLACK INK so that it may be copied.
2. Every reasonable precaution will be taken to protect your quilt; however, you may wish to check your personal insurance to ensure that your quilt is covered. The Goodtime Quilters, Ohio Christian University and the Registration Committee will not be held responsible for damage or theft of any entry. You may want to check with your insurance company for possible private coverage.
3. If your name is on your quilt, it must be securely covered if judged. Double or triple your muslin label cover if needed. Fasten label cover with large safety pins.
4. Each entry must not have been registered in our previous shows and must be (at least partially) your own work. Each entry entered will hang within its category in the Show Room.
5. The “Challenge” is “Baa-Baa Black Sheep, Have You Any Wool” After judging, entries in this class will be hung in the theme display area. Categories 27 and 28 will not be judged. Entries in categories 25, 27, and 28 must be entered on a standard entry form but will not be counted in the member’s total of 5 entries.
6. Quilts that arrive with odors (of any kind) and/or pet hair will not be accepted and will be returned to the entrant.
7. **All entry sheets must be in the hands of the Registration Committee by the June 5, 2025 meeting.** They may be mailed to Robbin Taylor (postmarked by 6/5/2025) if you won’t be attending the meeting.
8. All entries must be delivered to the university between 10 AM-Noon on Monday, July 21, 2025. If you cannot personally bring them to the university, please make alternate arrangements with a friend/guild member. Entries not received by the deadline will not be accepted.
9. The Committee and the Show Judge each reserve the right to re-categorize show entries.

Please print (in black ink). **A separate form must be submitted for each entry.** At this time, five (5) entries will be accepted from each member. Refer to item 5 above. If we do not secure enough entries from members, the committee may opt to go “invitational.”

Please select from one of the following Categories:

Categories 1-3 are Hand Quilted by the person who created the top.

1. Hand Quilted, Bed Size: Top may be pieced, appliqued or mixed technique. Shortest side is 60" or more.
2. Hand Quilted, Wall Quilt: Top may be pieced, appliqued or mixed techniques.
3. Lap Quilt: Shortest side not to exceed 60".

Categories 4-8 are Machine Quilted by the person who created the top.

4. Machine Quilted, Pieced, Bed Size: Top is primarily pieced. Shortest side is 60" or more.
5. Machine Quilted, Pieced, Wall Quilt: Top is primarily pieced.
6. Machine Quilted, Appliqued, Bed Size: Top is primarily appliqued. Shortest side is 60" or more.
7. Machine Quilted, Appliqued, Wall Quilt: Top is primarily appliqued.
8. Lap Quilt: Shortest side not to exceed 60".

Categories 9-13 are quilts made by more than one person. The quilt top is made by one or more persons and the quilting is done by another or others.

9. Bed Quilt, Pieced, Hand or Machine Quilted: Shortest side is 60" or more.
10. Bed Quilt, Appliqued or Mixed, Hand or Machine Quilted: Shortest side is 60" or more.
11. Wall Quilt, Pieced, Hand or Machine Quilted.
12. Wall Quilt, Appliqued or Mixed, Hand or Machine Quilted.
13. Lap Quilt: Shortest side not to exceed 60". Hand or Machine Quilted.

Categories 14-19 may be quilted by the entrant, another person, hand or machine quilted.

14. Mystery Quilt: Any size. Must indicate A. Fall Retreat or B. Spring Retreat, (current year).
15. Block of the Month: Previous year.
16. Golden Quilters: Entrant must be 75 years or older.
17. Scrap: Top must contain at least 50 different fabrics. Shortest side is 60" or more.
18. Baby Quilt: Designed for use on a baby/child's bed. Longest side not to exceed 60".
19. Miniature Quilt: Scaled down version of a large bed quilt design, maximum size 24" x 24" or 96" perimeter.

Categories 20-25 may be quilted by the entrant, another person, hand or machine quilted.

20. Pre-Print: Quilt originating from a pre-printed panel that **remains intact**. Borders may be added.
21. Modern Quilt: Quilt of unique design made with artistic intent, using color, design and construction techniques to create a work that expands traditional quilt design. All sizes of quilts are included.
22. Other: A quilt that uses one special technique to develop the design of the top such as whole cloth, crazy quilt, cathedral window, embroidery, tied, etc. Quilts in this category may or may not contain quilting stitches. All sizes of quilts are included.
23. Small Items: May include dolls, purses, totes, pillows, toppers/runners, etc. Quilting not required.
24. Wearable: Any garment that is appliqued, pieced and/or quilted. May or may not have quilting stitches.
25. Challenge: Baa-Baa Black Sheep, Have You Any Wool?.
26. Wool: Any Size, quilted or not, can be an original design.
27. Antique: All entries circa 1960 or earlier. For display only. Not judged.
28. Children's: For display only. Not judged. Participation gifts/ribbons may be given.

Awards: There will be a First, Second, Third and Honorable Mention ribbon for each category. However, the judge may use their discretion in awarding all places.
